

## **Top Ten HRO Journey Considerations**

- Safety culture is paramount
- Prevention is achieved through redundancy and resilience
- Emphasize mindfulness and attention to detail
- Strive for continuous learning and improvement
- Allow for decentralized decision making

- Implement standardization and protocols
- Focus on respect for expertise
- Be adaptable and flexible
- Seek external collaboration
- Take ethical considerations seriously

### Final Reflections – Key Take Aways

- Embrace the journey to high reliability, commit to it for the long term, consistently discuss and utilize the framework
- To achieve high reliability, it is crucial to integrate the framework into daily work. The ideal starting point is to create a space that enables leaders and managers to communicate effectively and visibly "close the loop" on ideas and concerns shared by frontline teams, enabling real-time coordination and improvement.
- Recruit local champions who will passionately embrace, take ownership of, and drive the work forward.

- Leadership engagement is a critical foundation.
- Education: concentrate on shifting mindsets to focus on risk rather than outcomes.
- Provide an environment of psychological safety.
- Support the process through an organizational structure: Office of Collaborative Reliability

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


#### **OUR MISSION**

# Organizational Overview – Tampa General Hospital

- Tampa General Hospital, a 1,040-bed, not-for-profit, academic health system
- One of the largest hospitals in America and delivers world-class care as the region's only center for Level I trauma and comprehensive burn care
- Highest-ranked hospital in the market in U.S. News & World Report's 2022-23 Best Hospitals
- Tied as the third highest-ranked hospital in Florida, with seven specialties ranking among the best programs in the United States
- Designated as a model of excellence by the 2022 Fortune/Merative 100 Top Hospitals list
- Recognized by two prestigious Forbes magazine rankings in the top 100 nationally in the 2023 America's Best Employers for Women and sixth out of 100 Florida companies in the 2022 America's Best Employers by State.
- Safety net hospital in the region, caring for everyone regardless of their ability to pay, and in fiscal year 2021, provided a net community benefit worth more than \$224.5 million in the form of health care for underinsured patients, community education, and financial support to community health organizations in Tampa Bay
- It is one of the nation's busiest adult solid organ transplant centers and is the primary teaching hospital for the USF Health Morsani College of Medicine
- · With six medical helicopters, Tampa General Hospital transports critically injured or ill patients from 23 surrounding counties to receive the advanced care they need
- Nationally accredited comprehensive stroke center, and its 32-bed Neuroscience, Intensive Care Unit is the largest on the West Coast of Florida
- Home to the Jennifer Leigh Muma 82-bed neonatal intensive care unit, and a nationally accredited rehabilitation center
- Footprint includes 17 Tampa General Medical Group Primary Care offices, TGH Family Care Center Kennedy, TGH Brandon Healthplex, TGH Virtual Health, and 21 TGH Imaging powered by Tower outpatient radiology centers throughout Hillsborough, Pasco, Pinellas, and Palm Beach counties
